READ ON TO LEARN HOW YOU CAN COMPLY



As described below, ClickBank vendors and affiliates must take several steps to comply with GDPR, including:

- Honor customer's requests to access, correct or delete their data
- Be capable of processing customer data for limited purposes—for example, to fulfill an existing order, but not for marketing
- Sign a contract with ClickBank agreeing to these terms
- Use appropriate technical and operational measures to protect customers' privacy

GDPR Background

• GDPR **becomes effective on May 25, 2018**. It applies to any person or business that sells goods or services to EU residents or deals with personal data of European Union residents. The definition of "personal data" under GDPR is broad—it covers any information that could identify the data subject.

CLICKBANK'S ROLE UNDER GDPR

- ClickBank is creating a unique order form that will automatically be served to EU customers. This form will include a checkbox that allows customers to opt-in to have their data processed for specific purposes, such as marketing.
- ClickBank will implement processes to honor any requests it receives from EU residents to correct, erase or transport personal data of EU residents.
- ClickBank will **revise its Client Contract and its Privacy Policy** to comport with GDPR.
- ClickBank will provide additional disclosures and consent rights to visitors of ClickBank.com
- ClickBank will disable certain features (such as automated product recommendations) that could be seen as "profiling".

ClickBank is an internet retailer and is the merchant of record for **all transactions** completed by its customers. ClickBank is a "data controller" under GDPR because it **receives and processes data about EU residents.**

VENDOR AND AFFILIATE RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER GDPR



VENDORS AND AFFILIATES **MUST** COMPLY WITH GDPR

If ClickBank receives a request from an EU customer to correct, delete or transport that customer's data, ClickBank will comply with the request, and it will also forward the request to any vendors who process the same data. Vendors and affiliates must be capable and prepared to comply with any such requests. In addition, vendors and affiliates must honor customers' requests to process personal data only for specific consented-to purposes.

ClickBank is not responsible for any customer acquisition activities that vendors or affiliates undertake outside of ClickBank's domains. Vendors and affiliates should consult their own counsel to ensure that their marketing practices comply with GDPR.
